Student mentorship program: 2016-2017 SEASON

The Greater Toronto Philharmonic Orchestra will provide mentorship program for young violin players for the 2016-2017 season.

The goal of this mentorship program is to provide young musicians with the opportunity to play with a high level orchestra and gain orchestral experience to develop their skills and build their experience under a professional guidance.

The term will last from September 2016 to May 2017: the full 2016-17 season.

During the duration of this program students will be provided one on one mentorship from orchestra's principals and conductors. This mentoring would provide professional insight and professional advice tailored to the strengths of each participant with the goal of their professional development.

Selected participants are expected to be able to play at a minimum Grade 8 RCM level (or equivalent) and attend *all* GTPO rehearsals which are on Sundays from 2:00 to 5:00 pm at Lawrence Park church.
